ARTS & CRAFTS VENDOR

BOOTH SPACE GUIDELINES

- Tables, chairs and light fixtures will be the vendor's responsibility.
- Vendors will offer only American Indian arts and crafts items to be sold (NO food or drinks).
- Only vendors who buy and sell traditional American Indian arts and crafts are invited to apply for inside spaces.
- No animals or pets of any kind permitted inside the building.
- The Arts & Crafts Area will be monitored, if there are any violations occur you will be asked to leave.
- Vendors will not misrepresent American Indian traditions to mislead customers in order to make a sale.
- Spaces will be 10' long by 8' deep.
- First priority will be given to American Indian vendors who sell traditional American Indian items.
- Vendors will not be allowed to set up without a signed contract.
- Each vendor space will be allowed one (1) parking pass per space. Additional parking passes may be purchased for \$20 for the week.
- Vendors are responsible for maintenance of their booth space.
- The American Indian Exposition reserves the right to refuse any contracts/vendors.
- Vendors will not sell or display any racist items (i.e. Confederate flag items).
